Mrs. Wendy R. Yonce is the Chief of the 436th Maintenance Training Flight in the 436th Maintenance Group, Dover AFB, Delaware. She plans, organizes, directs, and provides overall supervision of the Maintenance Group's Training Management. She is responsible for specific program implementation processes to achieve objectives through the management of the Engineering Technical Services, Maintenance Training Devices, Training Management/Formal Schools Scheduling, Air Mobility Command's Maintenance Qualification Training Program and Consolidated Unit Training Managers. Mrs. Yonce functions as the safety focal point through the maintenance resource management program as well as representing the Group and Wing on New/Modified Weapon System Training programs and Acquisition.



Mrs. Yonce began her Department of Defense career in 1999 as a Depot Maintenance Logistics Intern assigned to the Oklahoma City Air Logistics Center at Tinker Air Force Base, Oklahoma, where she served as a Logistics Management Specialist for the 76th Maintenance Wing. In mid-2002, Mrs. Yonce transferred to the Commander's Action Group, where she interfaced with HQ AFMC as the Congressional Liaison for the Air Logistics Center, and in 2004 she was promoted to represent the Center in Depot Activation through Public-Private Partnering in the Plans and Programs Directorate. There she also served as the Lead analyst for the Strategic Planning Branch and Chief of the Corporate Operations Branch. Later, she was promoted to Chief of the Strategic Planning Division where she was responsible for managing plans, programs, and readiness issues affecting the current and future missions for the USAF's largest Air Logistics Center. In addition, she integrated capabilities to deliver war winning technology, acquisitions support and sustainment to joint force combatant commanders. She led the development, execution, and measurement of command-wide strategic initiatives among four wings and ten directorates.
