Maj. Jeffrey D. Hayden is the commander of the 379th Expeditionary Maintenance Squadron. He is responsible for 450 military and civilian personnel in nine flights. The squadron provides intermediate repair capability supporting the 379th Air Expeditionary Wing's assigned B-1B, C-17, C-130, E-8, KC-135, RC-135 as well as transient and coalition aircraft. The largest intermediate maintenance squadron in AFCENT, it provides not only support to assigned wing aircraft, but theater centralized intermediate repair facilities for aircraft wheel and tire assemblies, KC-135 brakes, C-130 engines and propellers, patient therapeutic liquid oxygen systems, F-15E and C-17 Avionics and the theater Precision Measurement Equipment Lab.

Maj Hayden was born 11 Jul 1968 in Lorain Ohio and later graduated from Marion L Steele High School in June of 1986. He entered the military in 1986, as a Nuclear Reactor Operator aboard the USS Salt Lake City (SSN 716). In 1995 he received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Aeronautics

from Miami University and upon graduation was commissioned a Second Lieutenant via the Reserve Officers Training Corp (ROTC) program.
