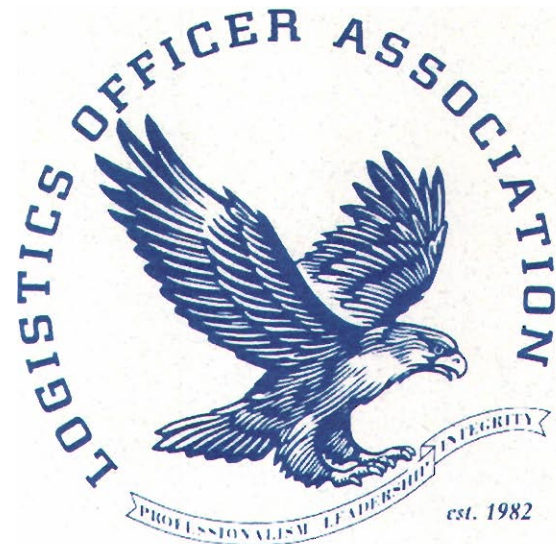

General John W. Handy
Air Force Vice Chief of Staff



General John W. Handy is vice chief of staff, Headquarters U.S. Air Force, Washington, D.C. As vice chief, and subject to the authority, direction, and control of the chief of staff and secretary of the Air Force, he presides over the Air Staff and serves as a member of the Joint Chiefs of Staff Joint Requirements Oversight Council

The general entered the Air Force in 1967 and received his pilot wings in 1968. He has commanded the 21st Air Force at McGuire Air Force Base; the Air Mobility Command's Tanker Airlift Control Center; as well as two airlift wings and a maintenance squadron. He has served as the Air Force's director of programs and evaluations, as the director of operations and logistics for U.S. Transportation Command, and in numerous headquarters-level staff positions. The general is a command pilot with more than 4,800 flying hours, principally in airlift aircraft. As a C-130 pilot, he logged more than 300 combat hours in Southeast Asia. The general assumed his current position in April 2000. General Handy has been a long time member of the Logistics Officer Association and has addressed several past conferences.

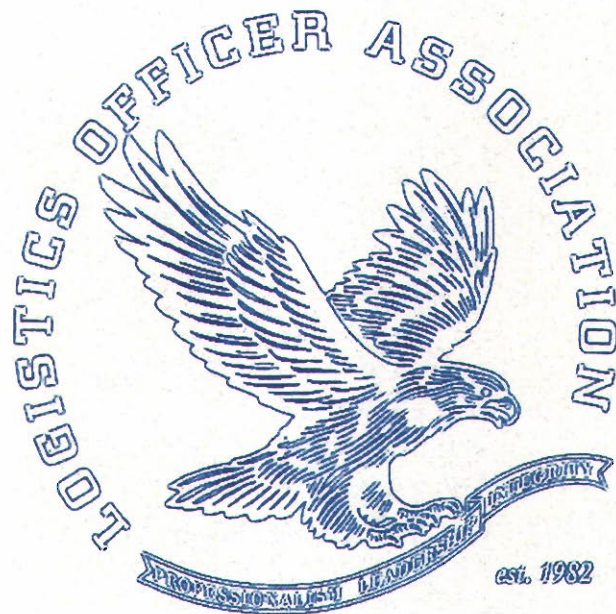
